

Roman Numeral Calculator



The Romans were noted for many significant advances in math, the sciences and fine arts. The numbering system they developed used Roman Numerals to common numeric values. The value of Roman digits are as follows:

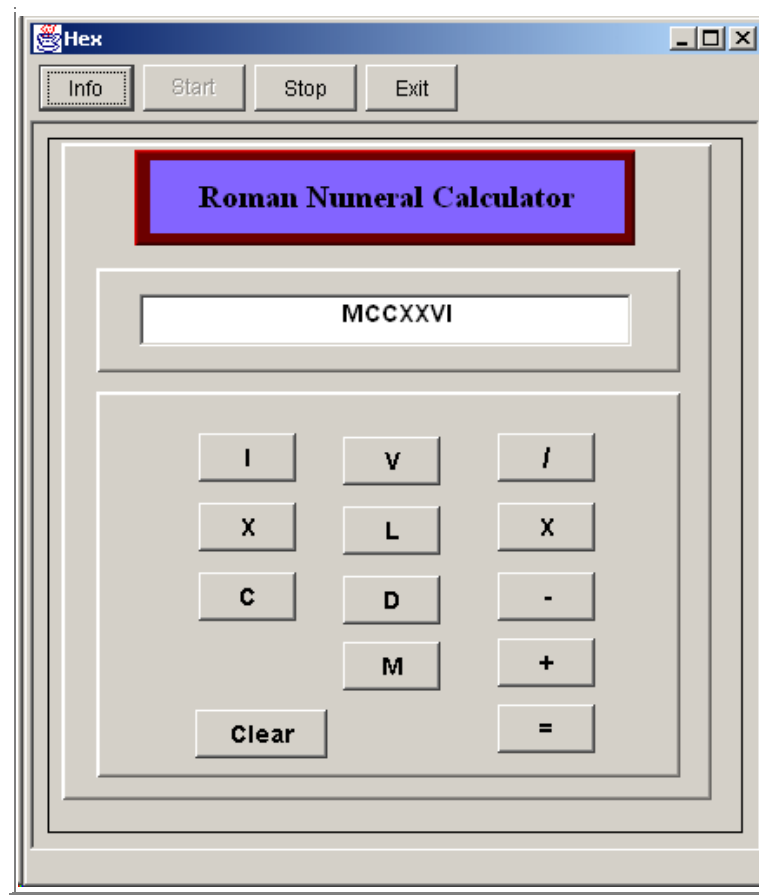


I	1
V	5
X	10
L	50
C	100
D	500
M	1,000

Design an applet that will allow the user to perform calculations on Roman Numerals. The arithmetic operators that your program should incorporate include: +, -, *, and /.

EXAMPLE:

- The number **MCCXXVI** is entered.



- b. The “plus” sign is pressed.
- c. The second number **LXIX** is entered.
- d. The “equal” sign is pressed.
- e. The following is the output generated.
